E. Supplemental Outreach Initiatives

- 1. January 25, 2024: WXXV TV sponsored and hosted a Job Fair at the Courtyard by Marriott Event Center in Gulfport, MS. The station was responsible for organizing the event, selecting the location and recruiting employer participants. WXXV TV participated as a potential employer along with 47 other businesses. Approximately 300 job seekers attended. WXXV TV used its broadcast signal and website to recruit employers to participate in the job fair as well as inform job seekers of the event. WXXV TV aired these announcements across our 3 broadcast networks a combined total of 1,060 times. These announcements are in the form of :30 second spot ads.
- 2. February 29, 2024: WXXV TV News Director participated in Mississippi Association of Broadcasters Day at the University of Southern Mississippi in Hattiesburg, MS. This is an outreach effort of the Mississippi Association of Broadcasters designed to help the students and faculty better understand the needs of broadcasters and today's work environment. The outreach effort also helps broadcast educators design programs to give the students a better opportunity for a successful career in broadcasting. He met with graduating students to critique their journalism demo reels and also participated on a panel to answer questions the students had concerning the broadcast industry. News Director conducted on campus interviews. Students were encouraged to visit WXXV25.com for current open positions.
- 3. March 5, 2024: WXXV TV Sales Manager and News Director participated in the University of Southern Mississippi Gulf Park Careers on the Coast Networking and Job Fair. Interviews were conducted with potential candidates for job openings in Marketing and News. Attendees were given a postcard with a QR code that links to the WXXV TV website employment page for an up-to-date listing of job openings.
- 4. March 19, 2024: WXXV TV News Director participated in Mississippi Association of Broadcasters Day at Mississippi State University in Starkville, MS. He met with graduating students to critique their journalism demo reels and also participated on a panel to answer questions the students had concerning the broadcast industry.

- News Director conducted on campus interviews. Students were encouraged to visit WXXV25.com for current open positions.
- 5. March 20, 2024: WXXV TV News Director participated in the Pearl River Community College 2024 Career Fair on the Poplarville campus. He met with graduating students in search of employment opportunities in Business, Marketing and Radio, Television and Film. The event gave students an opportunity to connect with career professionals.
- 6. April 3, 2024: WXXV TV News Director participated in the Mississippi of Association of Broadcasters Day at the University of Mississippi in Oxford, MS. News Directors from around the state were at the School of Journalism to talk with juniors and seniors about openings at their station. He reviewed and critiqued video packages submitted by college students. The critique session is a learning tool for the students to understand what television stations are looking for when evaluating prospective employees. He met with students seeking internships and employment in broadcast journalism.
- 7. May 22, 2024: WXXV TV sponsored and hosted a Job Fair at the Biloxi Civic Center. The station was responsible for organizing the event, selecting the location and recruiting employer participants. WXXV TV participated as a potential employer along with 21 other businesses. Approximately 200 job seekers attended. Job seekers were given a postcard with a QR code that links to the WXXV TV website employment page for an up-to-date listing of job openings. WXXV TV used its broadcast signal and website to recruit employers to participate in the job fair as well as inform job seekers of the event. WXXV TV aired these announcements across our 3 broadcast networks a combined total of 514 times. These announcements are in the form of :30 second spot ads.
- 8. September 26, 2024: WXXV TV sponsored and hosted a Job Fair at the City of Gulfport Lyman Community Center. The station was responsible for organizing the event, selecting the location and recruiting employer participants. WXXV TV participated as a potential employer along with 30 other businesses. Approximately 300 job seekers attended. WXXV TV used its broadcast signal and website to recruit employers to participate in the job fair as well as inform job seekers of the event. Job seekers were given a postcard with a QR code that links to the WXXV TV website employment page for an up-to-date listing of job openings. WXXV TV used its broadcast signal and

- website to recruit employers to participate in the job fair as well as inform job seekers of the event. WXXV TV aired these announcements across our 3 broadcast networks a combined total of 442 times. These announcements are in the form of :30 second spot ads.
- 9. WXXV TV is a participating employer in an ongoing virtual job fair hosted by our sister station, WWAY TV. The WXXV TV logo, business description and a link to our website's employment and job openings page is displayed. Interested applicants can view current job openings.
- 10. During the reporting period, WXXV TV had on-going training programs for employees in order to enhance skills on the job and expand working knowledge. General station training includes new hire orientation, safety training, and anti-harassment seminars for employees and supervisors.
- 11. Year-round, the news department trains staff in all areas of effective news writing and newscast production to improve current job skill sets and to advance their skills. Newsroom staff participated in an in-house seminar on Social Media Strategy best practices for a unified front to maximize social media opportunities from the newsroom. These sessions were recorded and archived for continual training.
- 12. Sales Manager and Marketing Consultants received Matrix, comScore (Rentrak), Wide Orbit and OSI training. The Sales Department has meetings which cover general business and selling techniques. Most meetings have training components. These consist of topics such as: negotiation strategies, Rentrak ratings data use, presentation methods, ChartLocal digital products and strategies.
- 13. During the reporting period, WXXV TV managers/supervisors participated in managerial training including "Managing Ethics: Code of Conduct Training for Managers". This training material provides information that helps managers/supervisors behave themselves ethically and promote a culture of integrity among their subordinates.

- 14. During the reporting period, WXXV TV managers/supervisors participated in video training "Management & Leadership Skills for Supervisors" as a refresher on understanding their people and knowing the right way to approach those tough challenges that seem to come up on a daily basis in the workplace.
- 15. During the reporting period, various school groups toured the station and observed the daily operations of a TV station. Tour participants were given an in depth look at the making of a television commercial and a live news broadcast. Station personnel discussed education that would be needed for a career in broadcasting and the opportunities of employment in broadcasting.
- 16. During the reporting period WXXV TV supplied speakers for events sponsored by schools, community and civic organizations. The awareness level of broadcasting as a career option is raised each time a staff member participates in community events.
- 17. WXXV TV posts vacant openings on our website and promotes our website on-air and across social media platforms to create awareness of the opportunities at the station.
